Primary Duties of Computer Scientists in FBI Field Offices:

Computer Scientist will be required to perform some, or all of the following duties, depending on the specific requirements of the individual assignment:

- \cdot Development and implementation of existing and custom Cyber tools and methods for use in the identification, preservation and analysis of digital evidence \cdot Provide technical assistance in conducting interviews, searches and other investigative activity
- · Provide courtroom testimony
- · Conduct liaison and outreach
- · Draft documents related to technical and other professional matters
- \cdot Remain current with new advances in cyber and technology topics and provide guidance on such matters
- · Obtain and provide technical and other professional training

Mandatory Qualifications

- · Applicant must be a United States Citizen
- · Applicant must be able to obtain a Top Secret/SCI Security Clearance
- Applicant must have a bachelor's degree in Computer Science or bachelor's degree with 30 semester hours in a combination of mathematics, statistics, and computer science, (15 of the 30 semester hours must have been in any combination of statistics and mathematics that included differential and integral calculus). Courses designed to provide an introduction to computer science techniques and methodologies are acceptable; course in teaching elementary, business, or shop mathematics are not acceptable.

Applicants should clearly state on their application/resume their experience in:

- · Internetworking (firewalls, gateways, routers, hubs, WANS, etc.)
- · Computer networking administration
- · Computer Programming
- \cdot Computer network architecture/design
