NNOA MEMBERSHIP INCLUDES ACTIVE DUTY, RESERVE, AND RETIRED OFFICERS FROM THE NAVY, MARINE CORPS, COAST GUARD, MERCHANT MARINE, NATIONAL OCEANIC AND ATMOSPHERIC ADMINISTRATION (NOAA), MIDSHIPMEN, CADETS AND CIVILIANS WHOSE GOALS ARE TO ACTIVELY SUPPORT THE SEA SERVICES IN ACHIEVING A DIVERSIFIED WORKFORCE THROUGH RECRUITMENT, RETENTION AND CAREER DEVELOPMENT. THE NNOA CONTRIBUTES TO MAINTAINING OPERATIONAL READINESS BY PROVIDING PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT, MENTORING, AND SUPPORT OF CULTURAL AWARENESS. NNOA IS ALSO A MEMBER OF THE NAVY AND MARINE CORPS COUNCIL. THIS YEAR'S CONFERENCE THEME IS "NNOA: CREATING OPPORTUNITY THROUGH LEADERSHIP, MENTORSHIP AND DIVERSITY."

REQUESTS MUST INCLUDE: NAME, RANK/GRADE, BILLET, UNIT/DUTY STATION, WORK PHONE NUMBER, AND IF YOU ATTENDED AN NNOA CONFERENCE PREVIOUSLY (INDICATE WHAT YEAR YOU ATTENDED).

3. THE UNIFORM OF THE DAY FOR THE CONFERENCE WILL BE BLUE DELTA WITH RIBBONS (NO MARKSMANSHIP BADGES). THE UNIFORM FOR THE AWARDS BANQUET WILL BE EVENING DRESS (BLUE-WHITE DRESS "A" FOR CAPTAINS AND BELOW).

4. THE ANNUAL PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT AND TRAINING CONFERENCE INCLUDES EDUCATIONAL WORKSHOPS, SEMINARS AND EXHIBITS, WHICH ARE DESIGNED TO ENHANCE THE PROFESSIONAL KNOWLEDGE OF ATTENDEES WHILE INCREASING OVERALL AWARENESS OF ISSUES AFFECTING THE SEA SERVICES.
